As a 501(c)(3), there are many requirements placed on the association by the IRS; therefore, Virginia PTA has a duty of care and fiduciary responsibility to ensure local PTAs adhere to those requirements. Virginia PTA's staff and the Vice President of Local Unit Operations shall be responsible for monitoring compliance of all PTAs. The councils, in represented areas, shall review local unit status reports and make contact with local PTAs that are not in good standing and offer assistance with obtaining compliance. Local Units in unrepresented areas will be assisted by the Virginia PTA Board of Directors. Supporting documents and information can be found on the Virginia PTA website at <u>vapta.org</u>.

In the event a local PTA fails to meet the minimum Standards of Affiliation, the local unit executive committee will be notified in writing of the intent to revoke the PTA's charter with Virginia PTA. Appropriate school administration officials will be copied on the written notice of revocation.
