# Presidents's Welcome - Brittany Heare

Brittany welcomed everyone to the meeting.

#### Treasurer's Report - Nadira Asghar

- September + Recent Spends
  - Balance is \$24,200 at end of Sept
  - Recent spends include teacher reimbursements, teacher appreciation, refrigerator, and prep for Fall Fest
    - Planning for an upcoming expense of \$4,500 for software
    - APEX final update and spend discussion: Brittany Heare
      - Past couple years netted around \$45k
      - This year netted \$53.5k. Breakdown is as followed:
        - Total Collected: \$90,668.77
        - JB Watkins Elementary PTA Net (59%): \$53.494.57
        - 5% retainage: \$2,673.55 (held for 30 days for possible requested refunds)
        - First ACH of \$50,781.02
      - Apex will deposit \$50k at first and then the remaining in the coming weeks to account for any refund requests, etc.
      - Apex funds will go to:
        - PTA operating budget
        - Resource teachers PTA will give \$1k to each resource department

- Playground enhancements PTA will give \$25k. Trying to get additional funding from the county to supplement
- Apex donated a sound system because Watkins met the fundraising goal

- Mrs. Duignam promoting it in art class and giving time in art class to work on it. She is also reinforcing the digital entry process instead of hard copy.

#### Playground Improvements – Arielle Greene

- In conversations with Chesterfield County, deemed that from an equity perspective, JBW does have enough play structures for students, so likely will not get additional funding from the county.
- Still trying to pursue an ECSE playground and to have play set replaced with structures that are ADA compliant. Still asking for the \$10k originally quoted by Mark Miller and asking for additional. Waiting for response from county on funding and way ahead.
- Musical structure would be about \$4,600 with labor. Hoping to be installed by January.
- Cost savings if we do all playground enhancements at once.
- Conversation surrounding fencing in Kindergarten playground
  - Kindergarten structure is appropriate for ECSE and would just need to be contained in order for ECSE students to use it— Wendy Wender expressed this could be a good solution
    - Mrs. McGonigle brought up issue of student safety and her preference to use the more confined area where the current ECSE play area is.
